TERMS AND CONDITIONS / TOUR CONTRACT

TOUR PRICE: Based on tariffs and currency exchange rates in effect on 5/24/2016 and subject to change without notice should there be a revision in rates prior to departure of tour. The tour price is based on a minimum of 36 passengers. Should there be fewer, there could be a surcharge.

ACCOMMODATIONS: In first class hotels or better, based on double or triple occupancy with private facilities. Single-room supplement is \$79 per night and based on availability. Requests for a roommate are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis and are not guaranteed. The single-room supplement will be assessed if a roommate is not available when the group is finalized.

MEALS: Five full hot breakfasts and five dinners throughout the basic tour (continental breakfasts in hotels only where full breakfasts are not available). Extra charge for beverage not included in the menu of the day.

TIPS AND TAXES: Those normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as "service" are included. <u>Airport fees, departure taxes</u>, and fuel surcharges are estimated on the original invoice and adjusted at the time of ticketing.

SIGHTSEEING: By modern motorcoach, including services of English-speaking guides and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary. Masses at churches indicated are subject to availability.

NOT INCLUDED: 1: Airport fees, departure taxes and fuel surcharges (est. - \$679); 2: tips to guides and drivers, meal servers and luggage handlers (\$73.50); and 3: optional travel protection. An amount to cover these items will be added to your original invoice. Also not included: domestic baggage fees, passport and visa fees, laundry, wines, liquors, meals not included in the itinerary, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned and items of a personal nature. Note: Due to limited storage space on motor coaches, Pentecost Tours entitles each passenger to one checked bag and one carry-on bag that meets airline "size/weight" allowances. Domestic baggage fees, overweight baggage charges, and fees for additional bags fall under the responsibility of the passenger. Be aware, while you may agree to pay fees for additional luggage, there may not be room on the motor coach.

ASSISTANCE: Pilgrims who require personal assistance must be accompanied by a paying passenger who will provide that assistance.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure reservations, which sum will be applied to the price of the tour, with the balance to be paid in full no later than 2/10/2017. Payment of remaining balance received after 2/10/2017 will incur a \$50 penalty. Reservations made within 90 days of departure may be subject to a late charge. In the event of cancellation, refund will be made up to 1/11/2017 with a \$100 administrative fee plus any airline cancellation penalties. From 1/11/2017 to 2/10/2017 the cancellation penalties, From 1/11/2017 to 2/10/2017 the cancellation penalties, or an amount equal to expenses to the tour operator, whichever is greater. There will be no refund for cancellations within 33 days of departure. Cancellation must be in writing and the effective date will be the date that Pentecost Tours, Inc. receives it. In the event 15 passengers do not book the tour within 120 days of departure, the agent reserves the right to cancel the tour. If the entire tour is cancelled by Pentecost Tours, Inc., you are entitled to a full refund.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip Chicago/Lisbon and Lisbon/Chicago on economy class jet via Delta/KLM or any other IATA member. Based on 6-day minimum/21-day maximum advanced purchase fare, subject to participation of ten persons on entire flight itinerary. If cancellation is effected by passenger after 2/10/2017, or after air tickets are whichever comes first, 100% of airfare will be forfeited by passenger in addition to the penalties mentioned above. All airfares are subject to government approval and change without notice.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel Protection is NOT included in the tour price. We highly suggest that all participants purchase a plan to help protect your trip and your investment. Plans offer benefits for trip cancellation/interruption, accident & sickness medical expense, emergency evacuation & repatriation, and more. You will be mailed a travel protection brochure along with a waiver form, in the event that you choose to decline coverage. The Plan Document will be provided, upon purchase. Read through this document carefully as it contains full plan and benefit details and exclusions & limitations. Please note that Medicare does not provide coverage outside of the United States. Check with your own insurance provider to determine whether or not you are covered outside of the U.S.

Day 1: Thursday, May 11, 2017, - USA / AMSTERDAM Tour members are welcomed this evening at an International Airport for our **departing flight to Amsterdam** via jumbo jet, arriving the next day. Meals are served onboard.

Day 2: Friday 5/12 AMSTERDAM / LISBON / FATIMA


Our flight connects from Amsterdam to Lisbon, Portugal. Upon arrival in Lisbon, we meet our driver and full-time tour escort and continue our journey into Fatima for tomorrow's centennial celebration of one of the greatest events that took place there. We take an orientation tour of the shrine and then proceed to our hotel to check in for a welcome dinner. After dinner, we participate in reciting the rosary and the candlelight procession. Overnight in Fatima. [D]



Day 3: Saturday 5/13 FATIMA

With messages for the faithful, Mary Mother of God appeared to three village shepherd children on the 13th of each month, from May through October of the year 1917. Today marks the 100th anniversary of the first message. "I desire that a chapel be built here in my honor. I am the Lady of the Rosary. I have come to warn the faithful to amend their lives and to ask pardon for their sins. People must pray the rosary every day and bear all the sufferings that God sends them," was her message to the children. Today we **participate in the anniversary celebration**. We return to our hotel for dinner before our **participation in reciting the rosary and our walk in the candlelight procession.** Overnight in Fatima. **[B,D]**

Day 4: Sunday 5/14 FATIMA





where we visit the **Chapel of** the Apparitions, celebrate Mass at the Basilica (subject to confirmation) that houses the tombs of Francisco and Jacinta, and the **Perpetual** Adoration Chapel. We continue to Aljustrel, where we visit the home of the Marto family (the birthplace of Jacinta and Francisco) and then the **home of Lucia**. In Aljustrel, we also see the **site of the apparitions of St Michael to the children**. We follow the **Way of the Cross** and **visit Valinhos**, the site of Our Lady's fourth apparition. Before returning to our hotel, we visit the **parish church** where the children were baptized. This evening we again take part in the **Candlelight Procession**. Dinner and overnight in Fatima. **[B,D]**

Day 5: Monday 5/15 FATIMA / ALCOBAÇA / OBIDOS / SANTA-REM / FATIMA

This morning, we begin with a visit to Alcobaça, a town southeast of Fatima to visit the monastery of Santa Maria de Alcobaça, an architectural masterpiece. The nave is immense, the transept has medieval tombs, to the right you will see the final resting place of Inês de Castro, and to the left lies the remains of King Pedro I who before his death ordered his resting place opposite that of his true love. Inês, who was brutally murdered. The monasterv was home to monks for nearly 800 years. We depart Alcobaca for the spectacular medieval walled town of Óbidos. An old roval tradition whereby kings offered the city to their wives gave way to the town's nickname, the 'Town of Queens'. In Obidos, we will see charming churches that were erected in celebration and honor of a queen who had given birth to a child. This town is beautifully adorned with well-preserved white homes, architecturally designed to incorpocontemporary rate Portuguese, Spanish, Italian, and Flemish elements, small cozy squares and romantic recesses. The town boasts architectural treasures that include: the Misericórdia Church (c. 15th), the São Pedro Church (c. 18th) and the São Martinho

Chapel (c. 14th), and the Paço Real (Royal Palace). You may catch a glimpse of the aqueduct. This town is sure to offer plenty of photo opportunities as it is one of the most pic-



turesque and most visited towns in the country. Next, we visit Santarem to visit and celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Stephen (subject to confirmation), where a Eucharistic miracle took place in the 13th century. When a woman attempted to steal a consecrated Host from Mass, the Host visibly became flesh and began to bleed. To this day the precious relic remains incorrupt for all to see. The church has since been renamed the Church of the Holy Miracle. From there, we **return** to Fatima for dinner and overnight. [B,D]

Day 6: Tuesday 5/16 FATIMA / LISBON

We bid farewell to Fatima and travel south to Lisbon to enjoy a brief scenic tour of Lisbón. We view Rossio and Comercio squares, drive through the old quarter and stop to visit the birthplace of St. Anthony of Padua and the church dedicated to him. Tradition tells us that the church was built on the site where the saint was born, in 1195. Then, we visit and celebrate Mass at the oldest church in the city, 12th century Lisbon Cathedral (subject to confirmation). Next, we visit the Basilica da Estrela, an obligation promised by Queen Mary I of Por-tugal after birthing an heir to the Portuguese throne. The enormous church can be seen from the distance. From there, we visit the Church of St. Roque. The rich interior décor dates back to the 16-18th centuries and continues to draw

many visitors to the city. Our journey now takes us to **St. George Castle, Belem Tower and St. Jeronimos Monastery**. We check in at our hotel for a **farewell dinner** and overnight. **[B,D]**





Day 7: Wednesday, May 17, 2017, LISBON / AMSTERDAM / USA

Today we begin our **journey back to the United States**. We arrive home amazed by the grandeur of God's beautiful landscape and inspired by the spiritual example of the saints. **[B]** To Register:
