

TERMS AND CONDITIONS / TOUR CONTRACT

TOUR PRICE: Based on tariffs and currency exchange rates in effect on 10/25/2016 and subject to change without notice should there be a revision in rates prior to departure of tour. The tour price is based on a minimum of 36 passengers. Should there be fewer, there could be a surcharge.

ACCOMMODATIONS ON JULY 31 AND AUGUST 5-6,

2017: In first class hotels or better, based on double or triple occupancy with private facilities. Single-room supple-ment is \$59 per night and based on availability. Requests for a roommate are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis and are not guaranteed. The single-room supplement will be assessed if a roommate is not available when the group is finalized. is finalized.

MEALS: Three full hot breakfasts and two dinners through-out the basic tour (continental breakfasts in hotels only where full breakfasts are not available). Extra charge for bev-erage not included in the menu of the day.

TIPS AND TAXES: Those normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as "service" are included. Airport fees and departure taxes are estimated on the original invoice and adjusted at the time of ticketing.

SIGHTSEEING: By modern motorcoach and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary. Masses at churches indicated are subject to availability.

NOT INCLUDED: 1: Airport fees, departure taxes (est. -\$109); 2: tips to guides and drivers, meal servers and lug-gage handlers (\$13.50); and 3: optional travel protection. An amount to cover these items will be added to your original invoice. Also not included: domestic baggage fees, passport and visa fees, laundry, wines, liguors, meals not included in the itinerary, sightseeing or services other than those specif-ically mentioned and items of a personal nature. Note: Due to limited storage space on motor coaches, Pentecost Tours entitles each passenger to one checked bag and one car-ry-on bag that meets airline "size/weight" allowances. Do-mestic baggage fees, overweight baggage charges, and fees for additional bags fall under the responsibility of the pas-senger. Be aware, while you may agree to pay fees for addi-tional luggage, there may not be room on the motor coach.

ASSISTANCE: This tour is a WALKING/HIKING pilgrimage which will require highly intensive daily cross-country walk-ing through varying terrain. It could be a very difficult ex-perience for individuals not accustomed to doing a lot of walking. Pilgrims who require personal assistance must be accompanied by a paying passenger who will provide that accustore.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of \$500 per per-son is required to secure reservations, which sum will be ap-plied to the price of the tour, with the balance to be paid in full no later than 4/28/2017. Payment of remaining balance received after 4/28/2017 will incur a \$50 penalty. Reserva-tions made within 93 days of departure may be subject to a late charge. In the event of cancellation, refund will be made up to 3/27/2017 with a \$100 administrative fee plus any air-line cancellation penalties. From 3/27/2017 to 4/28/2017 the cancellation penalties. From 3/27/2017, refund will be subject to a minimum 40% cancellation fee plus any airline cancellation penalties, or an amount equal to expens-es to the tour operator, whichever is greater. There will be no refund for cancellations within 48 days of departure. Can-cellation must be in writing and the effective date will be the date that Pentecost Tours, Inc. receives it. In the event 15 passengers do not book the tour within 125 days of de-parture, the agent reserves the right to cancel the tour. If the entire tour is cancelled by Pentecost Tours, Inc., you are entitled to a full refund.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip Chicago/Santiago de Compostela and Santiago de Compostela/Chicago on economy class jet via Iberia or any other IATA member. Based on 6-day minimum/21-day maximum advanced purchase fare, subject to participation of ten persons on entire flight itinerary. If cancellation is effected by passenger after 4/28/2017, or after air tickets are written, whichever comes first, 100% of airfare will be forfeited by passenger in addition to the penalties mentioned above. All airfares are subject to government approval and change without notice.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel Protection is NOT included in the tour price. We highly suggest that all participants purchase a plan to help protect your trip and your investment. Plans offer benefits for trip cancellation/interruption, accident & sickness medical expense, emergency evacuation & repatriation, and more. You will be mailed a travel protection brochure along with a waiver form, in the event that you choose to decline coverage. The Plan Document will be provided, upon purchase. Read through this document carefully as it contains full plan and benefit details and exclusions & limitations. Please note that Medicare does not provide coverage outside of the United States. Meals each day are "on your own" except where included breakfasts are marked

Day 1: Sunday, July 30, 2017, USA / MADRID Tour members are welcomed at an international airport for our departing flight to Madrid, arriving the next morning. Meals are served onboard the aircraft.

Day 2: Monday 7/31, MADRID / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA / LUGO

Upon arrival in Madrid, we take a **connecting flight** to Santiago de Compostela. Then, we board our motor coach, stop to collect our Pilgrim Passport and travel to Lugo where we check in at our hotel for a welcome dinner and overnight. [D]

NOTE:

Your Pilgrim Passport should be stamped at various sites (churches, restaurants, etc) throughout the locations you travel through, which serves as your "proof" for certification that you walked the camino. Be sure to have it with you at all times. Be certain to acquire at least two stamps (from different towns/ villages/etc.) per day.

Day 3: Tuesday 8/1, LUGO / SARRIA / PORTO-MÁRIN

This morning our motor coach will take us to Sarria where we begin the trek (the French Way/yellow route) back to Santiago. We walk on cobblestone streets, through interesting hamlets, discovering the tranquility of rural Galacia. As today's 13-mile camino jaunt leads us down a sharp decline into Porto-marin's main square. Steeped in history, remnants of the old village of Portomarin were saved from a devastating flood and rebuilt or repositioned in the village as it appears today. Along the banks of the Mino River, Portomarin is our home this evening. [B]

Day 5: Thursday 8/3, PALAS DEL REI /

SEDOR In the shadows of Palas, today's **15-mile** camino walk begins as we enter a rural stretch toward Melide, one of the largest stops on the Galacia route. The market town of Melide boasts of its simple octopus, potato, and paprika recipe that (when prepared properly) sets off your taste buds. Melide's Pulpo Gallego dish has become legend-

ary throughout Spain. Our camiño continues until we arrive in Sedor, today's final destination.

Day 6: Friday 8/4, SEDOR / PEDROUZO



Through the wooded landscape of oak and fragrant eucalyptus trees, farmed meadows and tiny, quiet villages, our 15-mile journey west will be filled with aromatic forest scents as we follow the ancient pilgrim trail and close in on Santiago. Upon our arrival

in Pedrouzo, we will stay put

Day 7: Saturday 8/5, PEDROUZO / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

The ultimate goal of our travel on the camino is in our sights as today's 13mile trek along a country road through sleepy hamlets will culminate in our joyous arrival in Santiago de Compostelá. But first, there are hills to be climbed before we can reap the reward of capturing our first look at the towers of Santiago. It's here that we take time to reflect on the lengthy



rural walk we leave behind to enter the culture of a bigger, urbanized city. Fulfilling our goal, we walk through Santiago de Compostela to the Plaza del Obradoiro and to the gates of the magnificent Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. Upon our arrival, we submit our stamp-filled Pilgrim Passport for our Compostela certificate. We attend the pilgrim Mass at 7:30 pm. This evening we enjoy a group dinner at the <u>hotel</u>. [D]

Day 8: Sunday 8/6, SANTIAGO DE COMPOS-TELA

After morning Mass and prayer and breakfast, today is free to enjoy the sites in the city of Santiago de Compostela. Suggestions include:

Visit the tombs of St Athanasius and St Theodore, and the Church of San Francisco.

Visit the Cathedral of St James (the patron saint of Spain and the brother of St John the Beloved). St James lived and preached in Spain for a time before he returned to Jerusalem, where he was the first Apostle to be martyred.

Get some rest and spend time reflecting on our journey. Overnight at our hotel. [B]

Day 9: Monday August 7, 2017, SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA / MADRID / USA

This morning we **transfer to the airport** to begin our journey back to the United States. We arrive home blessed by the experience of our camino walk, thankful to be a witness to the grandeur of God's magnificent landscape, and inspired by the way of St. James. **[B]**
