

TERMS AND CONDITIONS / TOUR CONTRACT

TOUR PRICE: Based on tariffs and currency exchange rates in effect on 2/17/2021 and subject to change without notice should there be a revision in rates prior to departure of tour. The tour price is based on a minimum of 36 passengers. Should there be fewer, there could be a surcharge.

ACCOMMODATIONS: In first class hotels or better, based on double or triple occupancy with private facilities. Single-room supplement is \$89 per night and based on availability. Requests for a roommate are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis and are not guaranteed. The single-room supplement will be assessed if a roommate is not available when the group is finalized.

MEALS: Ten full hot breakfasts and ten dinners throughout the basic tour (continental breakfasts in hotels only where full breakfasts are not available). Extra charge for beverage not included in the menu of the day.

TIPS AND TAXES: Those normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as "service" are included. Airport fees, departure taxes, and fuel surcharges are estimated on the original invoice and adjusted at the time of ticketing.

SIGHTSEEING: By modern motorcoach, including services of English-speaking guides and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary. Masses at churches indicated are subject to availability.

NOT INCLUDED: ①: Airport fees, departure taxes and fuel surcharges (est. - \$709); ②: tips to guides, drivers and meal servers (\$161.50); and ③: optional travel protection. An amount to cover these items will be added to your original invoice. Also not included: airline baggage fees, luggage handlers, passport and visa fees, laundry, wines, liquors, meals not included in the itinerary, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned and items of a personal nature.

NOTE: Due to limited storage space on motor coaches, Pentecost Tours entitles each passenger to one checked bag and one carry-on bag that meets airline "size/weight" allowances. Baggage fees, overweight baggage charges, and fees for additional bags fall under the responsibility of the passenger. Be aware, while you may agree to pay fees for additional luggage, there may not be room on the motor coach.

ASSISTANCE: Pilgrims who require personal assistance must be accompanied by a paying passenger who will provide that assistance.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure reservations, which sum will be applied to the price of the tour, with the balance to be paid in full no later than 10/23/2021. Payment of remaining balance received after 10/23/2021 will incur a \$50 penalty and/or a delay in your final travel documents. Reservations made within 92 days of departure may be subject to a late charge.

▶ [PENALTY PHASE ONE] In the event of cancellation, refund will be made up to 9/25/2021 with a \$100 administrative fee plus any airline cancellation penalties.

▶[PENALTY PHASE TWO] From 9/25/2021 to 10/23/2021 the cancellation penalty is \$500 plus any airline cancellation penalties.

▶ [PENALTY PHASE THREE] If cancellation is received after 10/23/2021 refund will be subject to a minimum 40% cancellation fee plus any airline cancellation penalties, or an amount equal to expenses to the tour operator, whichever is greater.

▶There will be no refund for cancellations within 45 days of departure.

Credit card processing fees are non-refundable. Cancellation must be in writing and the effective date will be the date that Pentecost Tours, Inc. receives it. In the event 15 passengers do not book the tour within 120 days of departure, the agent reserves the right to cancel the tour. If the entire tour is cancelled by Pentecost Tours, Inc., you are entitled to a full refund.

NOTE: Any change request/alterations to the group flight itinerary, requests for airline deviations and/or added domestic flights, automatically accelerates to a minimum PHASE TWO penalty level or the current level whichever is greater. Once the change request/alteration is made, those arrangements are final and can NOT be changed back to the group arrangement.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip Chicago/Tel Aviv and Tel Aviv/Chicago on economy class jet via El Al or any other IATA member. Based on 6-day minimum/21-day maximum advanced purchase fare, subject to participation of ten persons on entire flight itinerary. If caricellation is effected by passenger after 10/23/2021, or after air tickets are written, whichever comes first, 100% of airfare will be forfeited by passenger in addition to the penalties mentioned above. All airfares are subject to government approval and change without notice.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel Protection is NOT included in the tour price. We highly suggest that all participants purchase a plan to help protect your trip and your investment. Plans offer benefits for trip cancellation/interruption, accident & sickness medical expense, emergency evacuation & repatriation, and more. You will be mailed a travel protection brochure along with a waiver form, in the event that you choose to decline coverage. The Plan Document will be provided, upon purchase. Read through this document carefully as it contains full plan and benefit details and exclusions & limitations. Please note that Medicare does not provide coverage outside of the United States. Check with your own insurance provider to determine whether or not you are covered outside of the U.S.

MASS WILL BE CELEBRATED DAILY

Day 1: Sunday, January 23, 2022, CHICAGO / TEL AVIV Tour members are welcomed at an international airport for our departing **flight to Tel Aviv** via wide-body aircraft, arriving the next day. Meals served on board.

Day 2: Monday, 01/24, TEL AVIV / JOPPA / NETANYA Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we board our motor coach for our first sights of Israel. We proceed **to Jaffa** (biblical Joppa), the ancient port city where Peter sees a vision that all foods are clean, the start of the Gentile Mission, and where Jonah left prior to being swallowed by the whale. It was also here that Peter had his house-top experience. We visit the house and Church of St. Peter. From there, we complete today's journey as we travel **to Netanya** to check in at our hotel for a **welcome dinner** and overnight. [D]



Day 3: Tuesday, 01/25, NETANYA / CAESAREA MARITIMA / MT CARMEL / MAGDALA / TIBERIAS

Heading north along the Mediterranean is Caesarea Maritima, where St. Paul was imprisoned, tried, and sent from this Mediterranean banks of the control of the co terranean harbor to Rome. This is where we begin today. We visit one of Herod the Great's palaces and see the ruins of the ancient amphitheater next to the ocean. We journey north to the Stella Maris, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and the home of the prophet, Elijah in Haifa. Then, we head east to **Magdala**, birthplace and home of Mary Magdalene, a witness to the resurrection. We proceed to **Tibérias** to check in at our hotel for dinner and overnight. [B,D]



Day 4: Wednesday, 01/26, TIBERIAS / NAZARETH / CANA / MT OF BEATITUDES / TIBERIAS

We board our motor coach today and proceed **to Nazareth**, where Jesus played, grew up amongst the other children of the city, and later worked with Joseph in carpentry. It is here in the **Church of the Annunciation** just behind the altar where you can see the grotto where Mary said "yes" to the angel of the Lord. We visit St. Joseph's carpentry shop, the

Church of St. Joseph, and Mary's well. From there, we visit Cana where Jesus performed His first miracle, changing water into wine. The **Mount of Beatitudes**, site of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount is the perfect end to our day. We relax in tranquil and contemplative time before we return to our hotel for dinner. Overnight in Tiberias. [B,D]

Day 5: Thursday, 01/27, TIBERIAS / CAESAREA PHILIPPI / CAPERNAUM / TABGHA / PETER'S PRI-MACY / SEA OF GALILEE / TIBERIAS

We venture north to visit **Caesarea Philippi**, just north of the Sea of Galilee and at the base of Mt. Herman. It is here you will see one of the main springs of the Jordan River. Caesarea Philippi, also called "Banias", is the location of the testimony of St. Peter and where Jesus answered him, "You are the Rock and upon this rock I will build my Church." During our visit, we will see **one of the three springs that feeds the Jordan Rivers er**. On our way back toward Tiberias, we stop in **Capernaum**. This is the town where Peter lived and within which Jesus made his base of operations for His Galilean ministry. As we **visit the** ruins of the town you will find out why Jesus focused his ministry here, where ancient Judaism flourished. We will visit the **Synagogue** where Jesus healed and taught, and also **Peter's** house. Nearby, we stop at **Tabgha**, location of the miracle of

the loaves and fish of St. Peter's Primacy, where Jesus appeared after the Resurrection. We will close our day with a relaxing **boat** ride on the Sea of Galilee. We return to our hotel for dinner and an overnight. [B,D]



Day 6: Friday, 01/28, TIBERIAS / MT TABOR / JER-ICHO / OSAR EL YAHUD / MT OF TEMPTATIONS / MT SCOPUS / JERUSALEM The first part of our day will be

spent at Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. The church has two altars: one dedicated to the symbolism of Our Lord on earth and the other is dedicated to Jesus in Heaven. From there, travelling south parallel to the Jordan River, we stop in **Jericho**, the world's oldest city. Next, we stop at **Qsar El Yá**hud, the actual site where Jesus was baptized in the River Jordan, is nearby and we stop there to renew our baptismal promises. Then, we take the **cable car** to the top of the Mount of **Temptations** and then up to the Monastery of Temptation. We drive into Jerusalem where




we enjoy the spectacular scenery at Mt. Scopus to capture views of the Old City of Jerusalem. Then, we check in at our hotel for dinner and overnight. [B,D]

Day 7: Saturday, 01/29, JERUSALEM / BETHANY / QUMRAN / MASADA / JERUSALEM


Mary and Martha's home was in Bethany and the Tomb of Lazarus is there as well. We **explore Bethany** this morning. Then, we proceed to the excavations of Oumran, the Essene community connected with John the Baptist which is the site of the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. As our journey continues, we travel to Masada and ascend by ca-

ble car to the magnificent ruins of the fortress where from 70 to 73 AD, Jewish defenders made their last stand in the Judean revolt against Rome. Next, we stop to the **Dead Sea**, 1300 ft. below sea level (the lowest spot on earth), where we have the opportunity to "float" or lather up in the mud that is known for its mineral-rich properties. We return to our hotel to freshen up for dinner. Overnight in Jerusalem. [B,D]




Day 8: Sunday, 01/30, JERUSALEM / BETHLEHEM / EIN KAREM / ABU GOSH / JERUSALEM

We drive to Bethlehem today to visit the Church of the Nativity, the Manger, the Crusader's Cloister and the Grotto of St. Jerome. Then, we visit the cave in Shep**herd's Field** where the angels announced Jesus' birth and **view the Fields of Boaz** from the story of Ruth. We will have **free time to shop in Bethlehem**. We continue to **Ein** Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist, and the Church of the **Visitation**, where Mary uttered the words of the Magnificat. Our final stop today is at **Abu Gosh** where we **visit the Monastery** from the Crusader's era that commemorates the journey of the ark of God. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. [B,D]



Day 9: Monday, 01/31, JERUSALEM
Our first stop today offers a panoramic view of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives. We continue with a walk down the hill to **Dominus Flevit Chapel** where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. We make our way farther down the hill to visit the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Beside the garden is the **Church of All Nations**, built over the location where Jesus endured his Agony before praying at the **Grotto of the Apostles** (known to us as the grotto of betrayal and the arrest of Jesus). We **enter the** Old City through the Zion Gate and see the Cardo and the remains of Nehemiah's Wall on the way to the Western (Wailing) Wall. We visit the Davidson Center and visit the Church of St. Anne and the Pool of Bethesda. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. [B,D]



Day 10: Tuesday, 02/01, JERUSALEM

Early this morning, we prayerfully follow the Via Dolorosa (Stations of the Cross) through the old city ending at Calvary. We proceed to the Lithostrotos and a rooftop visit to the Convent of the Sisters of Zion. We visit Pilate's Judgment Hall, the Chapel of Flagellation, and the Arch of Ecce Homo ("Behold the Man"). Our day continues as we proceed to the New City of Jerusalem to Mount Zion, the Upper Room, the tomb of King David and Dormition Ahey. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. IR DI **Abbey.** We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. **[B,D]**

Day 11: Wednesday, 02/02, JERUSALEM We begin today with

an early morning, return-visit to the Church of the Holy **Sepulchre**, where we pray on top the Rock of Calvary and inside the Lord's tomb. We return to our **hotel for breakfast**. Our motor coach will take us first to the Israel Museum for a brief view of the Model of the City of Jerusalem at Jésus' time and a brief visit the Shrine of the **Book**, where we see the Dead Sea Scrolls on display. From there, we visit the beautiful **Church** of St. Peter of Gallicantu (The Cock Crows), location where Jesus was held in the house of the High Priest Caiaphas. We return to our hotel to prepare our bags for tomorrow's return flight to the United States. Our day and our pilgrimage comes to a close as we enjoy a group farewell

dinner. Overnight in Je-
